## Locking up the pavilion

### Till

1. Bag up and put away all cash in the safe (leave the copper).
2. Leave till open and switch off at the wall.

### Set Alarm System & Secure the Bar Area

3. Slot in middle support, close front shutters down and lock both.
4. Close side shutter, slot key barrels back in.
5. Turn glass washer off, and take out long grey plug.
6. Turn off all lights; ensuring 'Main Floods' switch and light in glass fridge (top left-hand corner) are off.
7. Ensure fridge doors are closed and close both doors in bar store room.
8. Press 'A' on alarm pad, close bar door and lock (3 different keys).

### Kitchen

9. Check external kitchen door is locked (two locks, same key).
10. Check cooker is switched off at main switch adjacent to cooker, check urn is off.
11. Extractor fan to be turned off, along with external light (next switch) and internal lights.
12. Check kitchen is tidy and dishwasher has been run (tea person should have done this)

### Men's Changing Rooms

13. Check shower extractor fan has been switched off.
14. Check all windows are closed and all taps are off.
15. Check emergency door in gents' toilets is closed, and bolted.
16. Ensure all lights are switched off.

### Snug Bar & Ladies' Toilets

17. Check all taps are off.
18. Check lights in toilets are off.
19. Check extractor fan adjacent to TV is switched off.
20. Check TV and music centre turned off at plug.
21. Check all heaters are off.
22. Check all windows are closed.
23. Check lights are off.

### Main Hall

24. Ensure the hall is tidy – collect and wash all glasses, tidy away remaining tea items.
25. Check three main front windows are closed and locked.
26. Check door to balcony is closed and locked.
27. Check external lights are switched off (players balcony, and by steps).
28. Check all heaters are switched off.
29. Switch off all internal lights and small external lights in lanterns.
30. Close main pavilion door and lock all three locks (same key).
31. Post keys into key drop.

## Tea instructions

### Shopping

6 loaves, 4 tins tuna, 500g cheese, 6 large eggs, 20 thick slices of ham  
whatever you want in or with the sarnies (salad, pickle, coleslaw etc)  
jar of mayo, tub of marger (but check the fridge, there may be enough there already)  
4 pints of milk  
cake - enough for 2 bits each, so 50+  
and/or fruit/yogurt if you are feeling healthy  
a pack of chocolate digestives goes a long way too

### When you get to the club

Fill (using jugs) and switch on the tea urn.  
When it is boiling, turn it down to simmer

Make the sarnies up,  
put them on the big platters,  
cover with cling film  
put them in the cold room behind the bar ready for later.  
Cut up the cakes and cover as above

Put the plates, mugs and sugar out

### Afterwards

Load the dishwasher with mugs, plates etc  
Wash up whatever pots, pans and platters you use

Please make sure you leave the kitchen clean and tidy for the next user.
